# CITY MISSION

**What is the cost?** A fee of \$80 (\$175 max/family) will cover the cost of food for the four days, minimal gas traveling to and from job sites, and some supplies. Please bring spending money for snacks, etc. There will be “**scholarship**” monies available should the cost become a concern. (Partial week meal plans available. Please let us know.)

**Who can go?** We’re encouraging families to share this experience together, to be a *family on mission* with others. Parents will be responsible for their children though we’ll have extra chaperones. A youth needs to be 18 years or older to come, if not accompanied by a parent. Both skilled and unskilled workers will be needed in many capacities. Please sign up as soon as possible.

**What type of work will we be doing?** Our mission projects will include clean-up of trash and litter, construction-related projects, landscaping, clearing of land, painting, gardening, preparing meals, etc.

**What to bring?** If you are staying on-site, you’ll need a sleeping bag, flashlight, and personal items. Tents and camping gear will also be needed, but can be shared. Detailed list is forthcoming.

**Other information:** We realize that not everyone is able to commit to the entire week. Partial participation in the week is welcome! Come one day, two days, or sleep at home and join us in the mornings, etc. Commuters are welcome. Whatever works for your schedule!

**Much like an old-fashioned tent revival, each evening we will celebrate with worship and special guest speakers. The broader community is welcome to join in for the evening gathering, even if unable to participate during the day!**

# Schedule

Not only will we be camping on the 14-acre landbase in Hernwood, Maryland, stewarded by *River’s Edge Ministries* but many of our participants will be commuting in each day. A large 30 ft. x 50 ft. tent will be erected for meals, worship, and fellowship; and separate camping areas for the men/women will be set up nearby. Also, please note that if you’re not commuting each day or camping at the landbase, we will suggest ‘indoor’ sleeping accommodations provided just 15-20 minutes down the road.
