Lutheran CORE provides via its website:

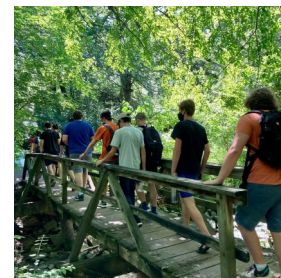
- daily devotions and weekly lectionary-based Bible studies

Resources for Congregations

- Congregations in Transition (CiT)—works primarily with call committees that are actively searching for a new pastor
- Congregational Lay Leadership Initiative—helps churches that have not been able to find a new pastor explore the possibility of transitioning to a long-term, lay-led congregational ministry model

Lutheran CORE is one of the sponsors of—

- The **NEXUS** program at Grand View University in Des Moines—a week of Bible study, theological reflection, fellowship, involvement in ministry, and being challenged to consider a life of Christian service, including the possibility of attending seminary



- The multi-generational, multi-denominational mission projects of River's Edge Ministries, based in Mt. Airy, MD:

⇒ **Cross Country Mission**—which involves travel to far-flung parts of the country to help communities rebuild from natural disasters like Hurricane Ian

⇒ **City Mission**—which involves travel to local sites near Baltimore, MD, provides urban relief that includes networking with community organizations and leaders that are already immersed in the mission field



- An annual **Encuentro** festival in the Chicago area—a day of support, connection, fellowship, inspiration and resources for those involved in bilingual and/or Spanish language ministry or considering such ministry
